Through Resolution <u>06.01</u>, the ASCCC actively supports the expansion of financial aid for all students in the state. The ASCCC Legislative and Advocacy Committee recommended at the October 2018 Executive Committee meeting that the ASCCC make advocacy of the expansion of Cal Grants one of our organization's top legislative priorities for the 2018-19 academic year.
