What would it look like?: Structure of an Online Event

- Options:
 - 1 to 2 day single event (several hours each day)
 - A week-long event (a few hours each day)
 - Weeks-long series
- General and break-out sessions?

Online Event Benefits

- Possible greater attendance more faculty, staff and students may be able to attend – some who couldn't otherwise
- Ability to create/feature more timely/relevant content (just in time)
- Better able to utilize the VRC for preand post-event communication – reaching folks who couldn't make the live presentations

Online Event Challenges

- Lots of online PD & events now how to distinguish the event/stand out?
- Keeping attendees attention may need to revise session lengths/timing
- Ensuring engagement and tangible take-aways
- Are presenters ready and willing to do virtual sessions?

How would the intent shift?: Content of Online Event

- Dependent on structure of event (single vs. series) and whether an in-person event will occur in spring
- Ability to provide more just-in-time PD? What are the relevant topics now?
 - o Equity in distance education
- How to ensure we engage college faculty, staff and students in their preferred ways and address what is needed?
- Call for Proposals extension
 - o Possible changes to the Call for Proposals webpage/questions?
